Presentation of the New Releases Standing Order

Libraries that subscribe to OpenEdition's Standing Order Service get immediate access to the latest releases in partner publishers' collections. This makes it quicker to make new titles available.

- Titles are purchased permanently, with no DRMs and unlimited downloads of PDF and ePub formats.
- Two purchase modes: by collection or by title, within the selected collections. An additional discount applies for the collection purchase mode.

Publishers' commitment: publication of digital and paper formats simultaneously or within 3 months maximum.

This offer includes all value-added [services](#) designed for libraries as part of the OpenEdition Freemium for Books offer (Counter statistics, Marc records, customized graphic design, etc.).

Terms and conditions

It is possible to choose one or more collections from each publishing house. The catalogue presents publishers and collections and for each collection indicates the number of titles to be published and the estimated purchase price per title.

The quote request form (Excel format) allows you to select collections. The estimated annual amount will be calculated automatically. The calculation is based on the number of titles planned by the publisher and the average book price in the collection(s) you have chosen.

In your quote request form,

1. Enable macros
2. In the "Catalogue" tab, select 1 in front of the collections you have chosen (column I)
3. Once your selection is complete, click on 'Confirm' and open the "Quote request" tab
4. This tab shows the selected collections and estimated annual amount. Fill in your institutional contact details
5. Choose selection "by serie" or "by title in the series" ;
6. Click on 'Print the quote request', then 'Print'. Select 'Print PDF' (or equivalent)
7. Save your quote request (PDF) and submit it by email to library-support@openedition.org.

We will quickly send you a quote with the applicable discounts. Your acceptance of this quote with discounts applied will validate your subscription.

If you are not yet a partner of the OpenEdition Freemium programme, you will need to submit a [form to open an account](#) in order to enable access.

- The books from the selected collections will be automatically opened to your users as soon as they are published online. You will receive a quarterly summary quotation before invoicing.
