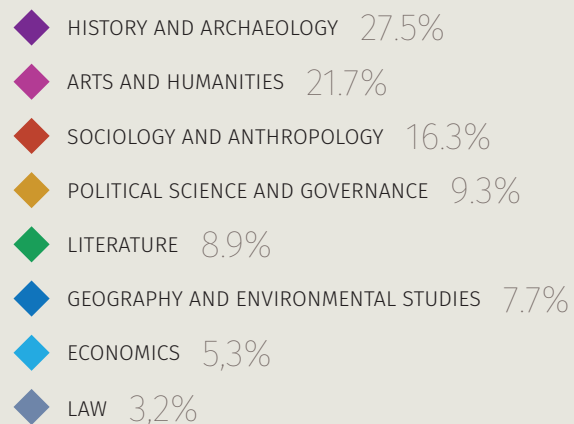

Bundles

It is also possible to create **tailored bundles**, such as publisher bundles, in order to meet the needs of partner institutions.

Reading formats

Users from partner institutions can access purchased content in all the available formats, with **no DRM or download quota**.

HTML: books can be read on-line in HTML format

Reader mode: enhanced mode for a more comfortable experience when reading on-line

PDF and ePub: books can be downloaded as PDF (full book and by chapter) and ePub (full book).
